Date	Site	Activity
Dec. 7 (overnight at JUC)	Arrival in Jerusalem	Arrive to JUC's campus
Dec. 8 (overnight at Cairo)	Arrival in Cairo	Depart JUC on bus and head south to Taba border. Cross at Taba border and travel to Cairo hotel for check in and dinner. (D)
Dec. 9 (overnight on sleeper train)	<i>Memphis, Sakkara, Djoser's pyramid complex, pyramid of Teti, tombs of Mereruka and Ptah-hotep, pyramids of Dashur</i>	Full day tour to Memphis, Sakkara, Djoser's pyramid complex, the pyramid of Teti, the tombs of Mereruka and Ptah-hotep. Lunch at a local restaurant and we travel to the pyramids of Dashur. Then, to train station to Aswan on the Overnight Sleeper Train (sleeping berths). (B, L, D)
Dec. 10 (overnight at Aswan)	<i>High Dam, Philae Temple, Nile, Nubian village, St. Simeon Monastery</i>	Full day field study to the High Dam, unfinished obelisk and granite quarry and Philae Temple, a motorboat excursion across the Nile, a Nubian Village, and camel ride to St. Simeon monastery. End the day at Aswan hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)
Dec. 11 (overnight at Luxor)	<i>Temples of Kom Ombo, Edfu, Karnak, Luxor</i>	Full day field study to the temples of Kom Ombo, Edfu, and Karnak with a nighttime visit to the Luxor temple. Travel to hotel in Luxor for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

Dec. 12 (overnight on sleeper train)	<i>Luxor's West Bank</i>	Full day field study to the Luxor's West Bank (the Colossae of Memnon, the Valley of the Kings including King Tut's Tomb, Deir el-Bahri, Medinet Habu, Deir el-Medina, and the Ramesseum). Overnight on Sleeper Train (sleeping berths). (B, L, D)
Dec. 13 (overnight at Cairo)	<i>Tell el-Yehudia, Khan El Khalil</i>	Upon arrival at Cairo Station, we'll travel to Tell el-Yehudia in Delta (the land of Goshen), then Khan El Khalil - the biggest bazar in Egypt. End the day at Cairo hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)
Dec. 14 (overnight at Cairo)	<i>Giza Pyramids, Sphinx, Papyrus Institute, Old Cairo</i>	Early morning visit to Giza Pyramids - the only remaining wonders of the ancient world - including the Sphinx. After lunch at a local restaurant, we'll visit Papyrus Institute - the Egyptian Museum which is located at El-Tahrir Square - along with Old Cairo and the ancient churches like Abu Sarga and The Hanging Church. End the day at Cairo hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)
Dec. 15 (overnight at Sinai)	<i>Sinai, Hathor Temple, Şerabit el-Khadim</i>	Full day field study in the western Sinai, including Moses' Spring (Elim), visit to the Hathor Temple and turquoise mines of Şerabit el-Khadim. End the day at St. Catherine hotel in Sinai for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)
Dec. 16 (overnight at JUC)	<i>Mount Sinai, St. Catherine's Monastery, Burning Bush</i>	Begin our final day climbing Mount Sinai. After watching the sun rise on the mountain, tour the famous St. Catherine's Monastery, then we'll stop at the Burning Bush. Return to Taba/Eilat, and on to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight on campus. (B, L, D)
Dec. 17	Departure from Jerusalem	Check out of JUC by 11:00 AM. Continental breakfast provided. (B)
