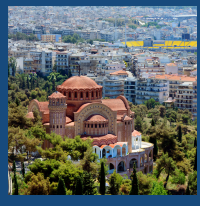


# LIFE AND TIMES OF PAUL

## DAY 1: Arrival in Thessaloniki

Arrive to Thessaloniki by 2 pm and meet the group at the designated location. Explore the Archaeological Museum of Thessaolinkki then travel to Kavala. Overnight in Kavala.



## DAY 2: Kavala (Neapolis) and Philippi

Begin in Kavala (ancient Neapolis), exploring its historic port and the Via Egnatia. Continue to Philippi to visit the Lydia River and the ancient forum, tracing key moments in early Christian history. Overnight in Thessaloniki.



## DAY 3: Thessaloniki, Veroia (Berea) and Vergina

Explore Thessaloniki's Roman Forum before traveling to Berea to visit the Old Synagogue and the Bema of the Apostle Paul. Continue to Vergina to see the Tomb of Philip II. Overnight in Kalambaka.



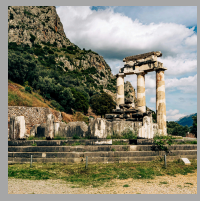
## DAY 4: Kalambaka and Thermopylae

Visit the monasteries of Meteora and a local icon workshop in Kalambaka. Continue to Thermopylae to see the monuments of Leonidas and the Thespians, the Simonides inscription, and the Phocian Wall, recalling the battle site. Overnight in Delphi.



## DAY 5: Delphi

Explore the ancient site of Delphi and its museum, one of the most important sacred centers of the ancient world. Overnight in Olympia.



## DAY 6: Olympia

Explore the ancient site of Olympia and its museum, birthplace of the Olympic Games and a major sanctuary of Zeus. Continue on to Nafplio for overnight.



## DAY 7: Epidaurus, Corinth, and Cenchraea

Visit the ancient theater and Asclepion of Epidaurus, then continue to Corinth to explore the archaeological site and museum. End at the ancient port of Cenchraea before arriving in Athens. Overnight in Athens.

Explore the Acropolis and Areios Pagos, key sites of ancient Athens and early Christian preaching. Overnight in Athens.
